

# ***LEAP LIKE A LEMUR!***



Most lemurs spend their time up in the trees, so they need to be able to easily move from one tree to the other when searching for food. They have thick pads on their hands and feet and 5 fingers and toes per limb, which allow them to grab onto branches in mid-air. A lemur can travel up to 25 feet in one leap!

- Mark your starting point, give yourself plenty of room, and leap as far as you can!
- Measure how far you jumped. You can try as many times as you'd like!
