White-cheeked gibbons live in tropical rainforests and eat a wide variety of foods including fruits, vegetables, leaves and insects. Gibbons spend most of their days in the treetops searching for food. Their long limbs allow them to swing from trees and grab fruits growing at the end of branches. Young gibbons learn how to find food by watching their mothers gather snacks throughout the day.
