Tigers have “true stripes”, which means that if you shaved their hair down, their skin would have that same striped pattern. Every tiger has its own stripe pattern, sort of like a human fingerprint, that allows us to tell them apart. Tigers use these stripes to blend in with their surroundings when they’re hunting. Without stripes it would be really hard for tigers to sneak up on prey!
